
This is a seek and match game.

The posts or little houses on the ground are all in pairs but they are spread along the pavement for you to find.


Each pair of posts is identical. Find the matching pair of posts and you have found the parents of a household. The flower that is painted on each of the posts will show you what country that parent comes from.

There are 47 combinations in total.

Here is an example:



These two posts are identical,  
they have an orange base  
and an aqua cap on the top.



The flowers on the posts show us that one parent comes from Australia (the yellow wattle flower) and the other parent comes from Lebanon (the poppy)
