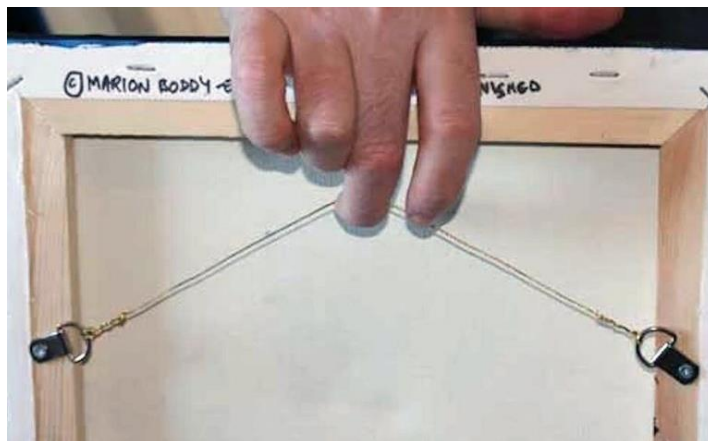
Dropping off artworks – judging requirements

- **Works must be delivered to Kingston City Hall between 2pm and 5pm on Saturday 20th March 2020**
- Please check in with staff and volunteers on arrival; your work/s will then be measured; your title card/s collected and you will complete the photographic permission form/s collected to confirm your works will be eligible for exhibition and judging
- Late entries will NOT be judged. Entries that do not adhere to the Terms and Conditions will NOT be judged. See our [website](#) for the Terms and Conditions.

2D Requirements:

- 2D works must not exceed 610mm (High) x 610mm (Wide) x 60mm (Deep) framed or unframed
- **All works must be ready to hang (i.e. wired at the back with large D-rings affixed.**
D-rings may be purchased from Melbourne Artists' Supplies (across the road from Arts Centre) or other art and framing shops.

Alternatively, you may also use a staple gun to attach strong twine to a canvas or backing board.

3D Requirements:

- 3D works must not exceed 600mm (High) x 400mm (Wide) x 400mm (Deep)
- **All works must be ready to hang (as above) or sit safely on a plinth.** All works will be measured on arrival. Wet works will be accepted as long as they can be handled without causing damage to the work, gallery or staff.

Please find enclosed:

1. Your Title Card that you will need to fill out (please print letters in block capitals) and bring with your work on Saturday 20th March.

Please note that works that if you intend to offer your work for sale that it must be given a price. The gallery commission fee of 22% needs to be included in your final price and any GST if you are registered to charge this with the taxation office. No minimum sales price applies.

- Uncollected works cannot be stored at Kingston Arts Centre and will be disposed of.

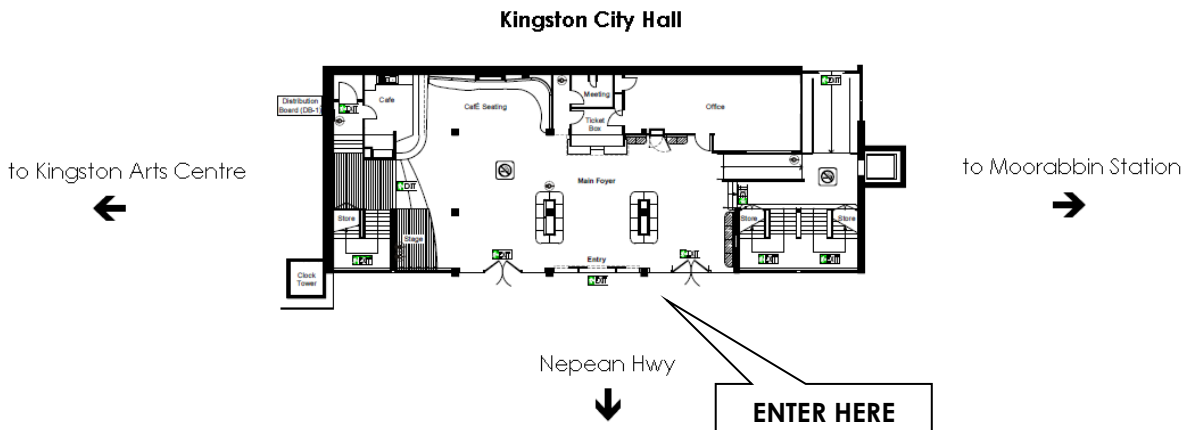
