- All creative writers will respond to the theme at the same time as visual artists; writing an original fiction or non-fiction piece in any style or genre.
- **Adult 18+ entrant word-length: 300-500 words**
- **Youth (13-17yrs) and Junior (12 and under) entrant word-length: 100 – 300 words.**
- All creative writing pieces should be submitted digitally as a word document via email.

Please note that no works within the writing category will be for sale.

How to submit

- Please submit as a word doc file and email to visualarts@kingston.vic.gov.au on **Saturday 14th March any time before 5pm.** No hardcopies will be accepted.

- **Please ensure you have included your name, the title of your piece and the final word count with your email submission.**
- If you and your child are attending the opening event, you must email a copy of the Photographic Permission via email with your creative writing entry.
- If you do not consent to your child being photographed during the opening event, please make yourself known to the photographer on the day.
- Late entries will NOT be accepted. Entries that do not meet the requirements will NOT be judged. No exceptions.

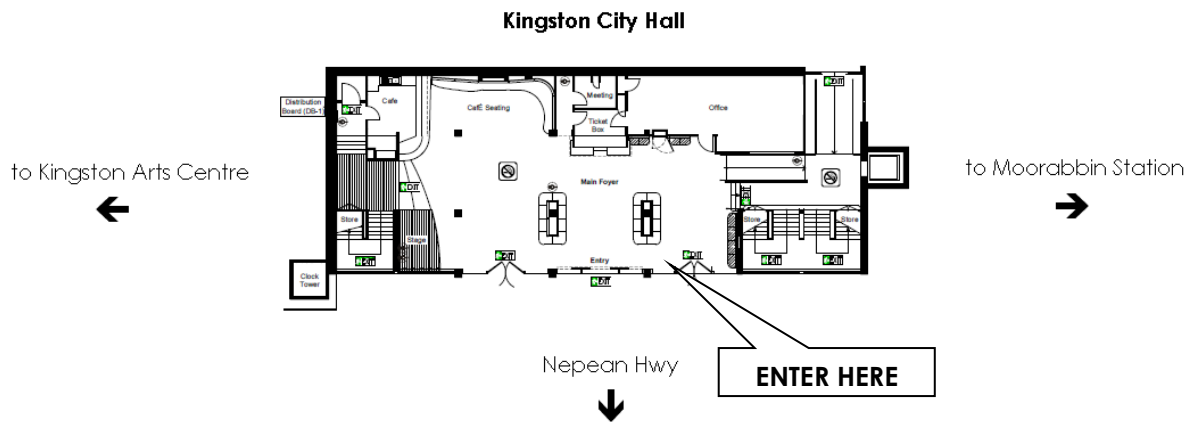

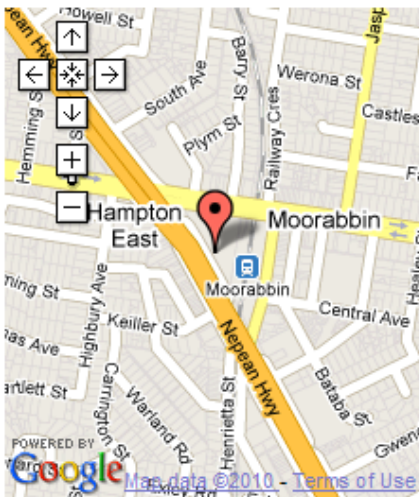
