Dear Artz Blitz Creative Writing participant,

Congratulations! This letter is to confirm your registration for Kingston Arts' *Artz Blitz 2019* competition. Just a few reminders before the big event!

### **Creative Writing format**

- All creative writers will respond to the theme at the same time as visual artists; writing an original fiction or non-fiction piece in any style or genre between 50 – 150 words, formatted to the constraints of a single one-sided white A4 piece of paper
- This may include drawings if you wish, but you must adhere to the word limit requirements and submit as a digital copy
- Softcopy digital word doc files are preferred

### **FAQ**

#### **Q. Can I write a non-fiction piece for the creative writing category or does it have to be fiction?**

You can write in fiction, non-fiction or even a mixture of both! As long as your piece of writing is between 50 and 150 words and formatted on an A4 piece of paper and delivered in a digital word doc file. You may respond with a short-story, poem, lyric, comic strip – it's completely up to you!

### **How to submit**

- **Please submit as a digital word doc file and email to [michelle.james@kingston.vic.gov.au](mailto:michelle.james@kingston.vic.gov.au) on Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> March any time before 5pm. Alternatively, you may submit as a hardcopy between 3 – 5pm only.**
- **Please submit photographic permission forms for children 17 and under (if applicable) via email with your creative writing entry.**
- **If you do not consent to your child being photographed during the opening event, please make yourself known to the photographer on the day,**
- Late entries will NOT be accepted. Entries that do not meet the requirements will NOT be judged. No exceptions.

## **Award Presentation and Opening**

- **The Artz Blitz Opening will be from 4pm - 6pm on Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> March and entry is free!**
- **Award presentations will be held at 4pm** in the City Hall Foyer
- Complimentary refreshments and a free art workshops by The Indirect Object. Your friends and family are very welcome to attend.

- **If you wish to collect your work after the exhibition, it must be collected after the Easter long weekend) – Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> April (12pm-5pm)**
- Artists or their representatives must produce suitable identification (i.e. Driver's Licence) when collecting work/s
- Uncollected works cannot be stored at Kingston Arts Centre and will be disposed of after the date unless alternative arrangements have been made in advance

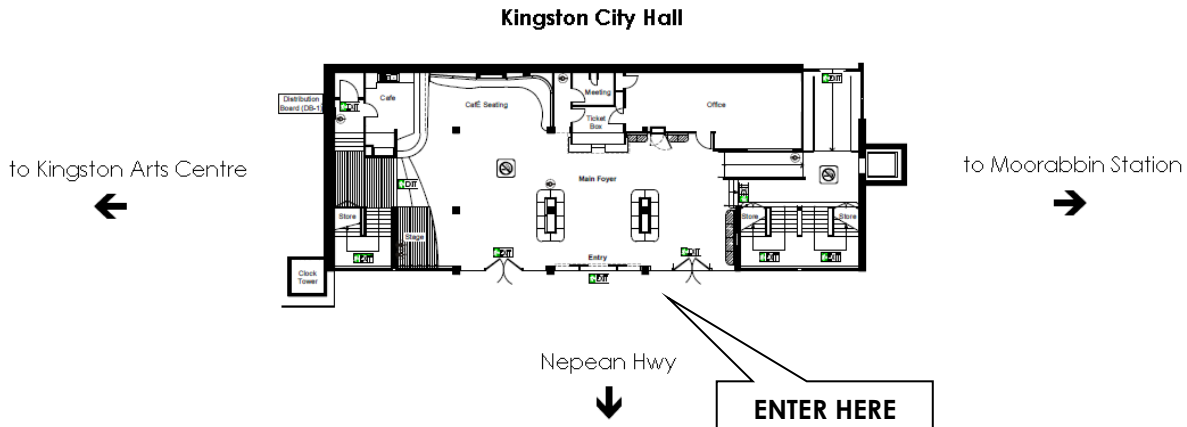
